The Daffodil Foundation was established by Daffodil Care Services (incorporating Social Care Training Ireland) in June 2015. The mission of The Daffodil Foundation is to "support and promote the wellbeing of young people in Ireland".

Our key areas of focus are;

- > to support young people leaving care, providing needs assessed financial grants,
- to deliver a national campaign of education and awareness in the areas of mental health and suicide prevention,
- supporting organisations working with young people and families in Direct Provision and campaigning for change to bring about a more humane process for those seeking asylum.

The second area of focus is our reason for contacting your school.

The Daffodil Foundation would like to give your school an opportunity to avail of our workshop for students titled 'Mental Health Awareness and Suicide Prevention'. This is fully funded by the Daffodil Foundation and will be <u>delivered with no cost to</u> <u>your school</u>.

The workshop can be delivered during a 40 minute period or a 1 hour and 20 minute period depending on what is convenient for your student's timetable. As part of this campaign, each school has an opportunity to inform us of any current issues arising in the school that facilitators may incorporate into the workshop in more detail. Some examples may include, bullying, self-harm, alcohol or drug misuse.

Our facilitators are qualified social care workers, who are fully Garda vetted and have vast amounts of experience in this area and working with young people.

The Daffodil Foundation invites schools to make an application for this workshop, by way of written submission.
